<u>Lunchbox Ideas – Boerewors and Tomato Frittata</u>

This month's recipe includes a South African favourite – boerewors! This recipe is tasty and packed with protein. With the rich flavours of boerewors and the freshness of tomatoes, this frittata is a delightful snack that will keep the kids satisfied throughout the school day.

INGREDIENTS

3 large eggs.

30ml full cream milk.

A handful of mozzarella or cheddar cheese.

Leftover boerewors about 15cm long. Olive oil.
1 large tomato, chopped.
1 small onion, chopped.
1 small garlic clove, chopped.
2ml dried mixed herbs.
Salt and pepper to taste.



METHOD

- 1. Spray a small (15cm x 15cm) ovenproof dish with non-stick cooking spray. Preheat the oven to 180 degrees.
- 2. Whisk the eggs, milk, salt and pepper together. Add about ¾ of the cheese to the egg mixture.
- 3. Heat the oil in a small frying pan and fry the tomato and onion. Add the garlic and mixed herbs and fry for another minute. Cut the boerewors into thin slices and add to the tomato mixture. Stir through to combine and remove from the heat. Taste and season with salt and pepper as needed.
- 4. Pour the boerewors mixture into the bottom of the prepared dish. Pour the egg mixture over the boerewors and sprinkle the rest of the cheese over the top.
- 5. Bake in the preheated oven for about 20 minutes until cooked through and nicely browned. Allow to cool to room temperature before cutting into snack sized squares.


